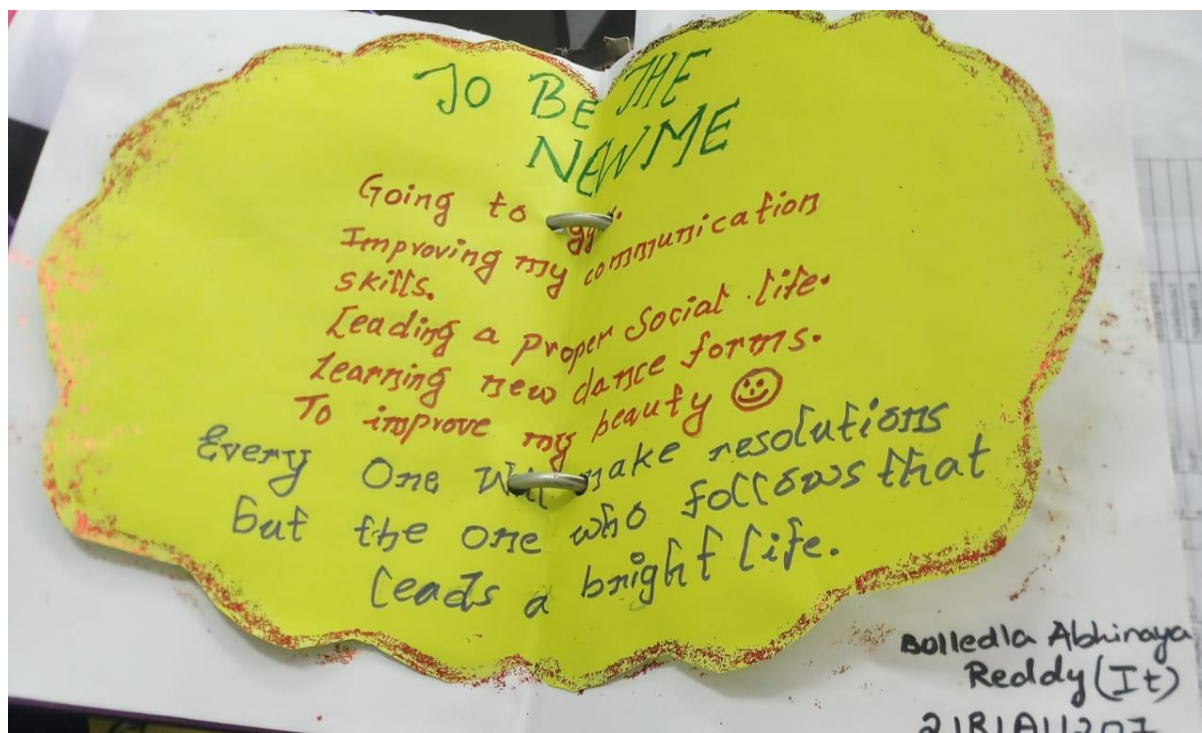

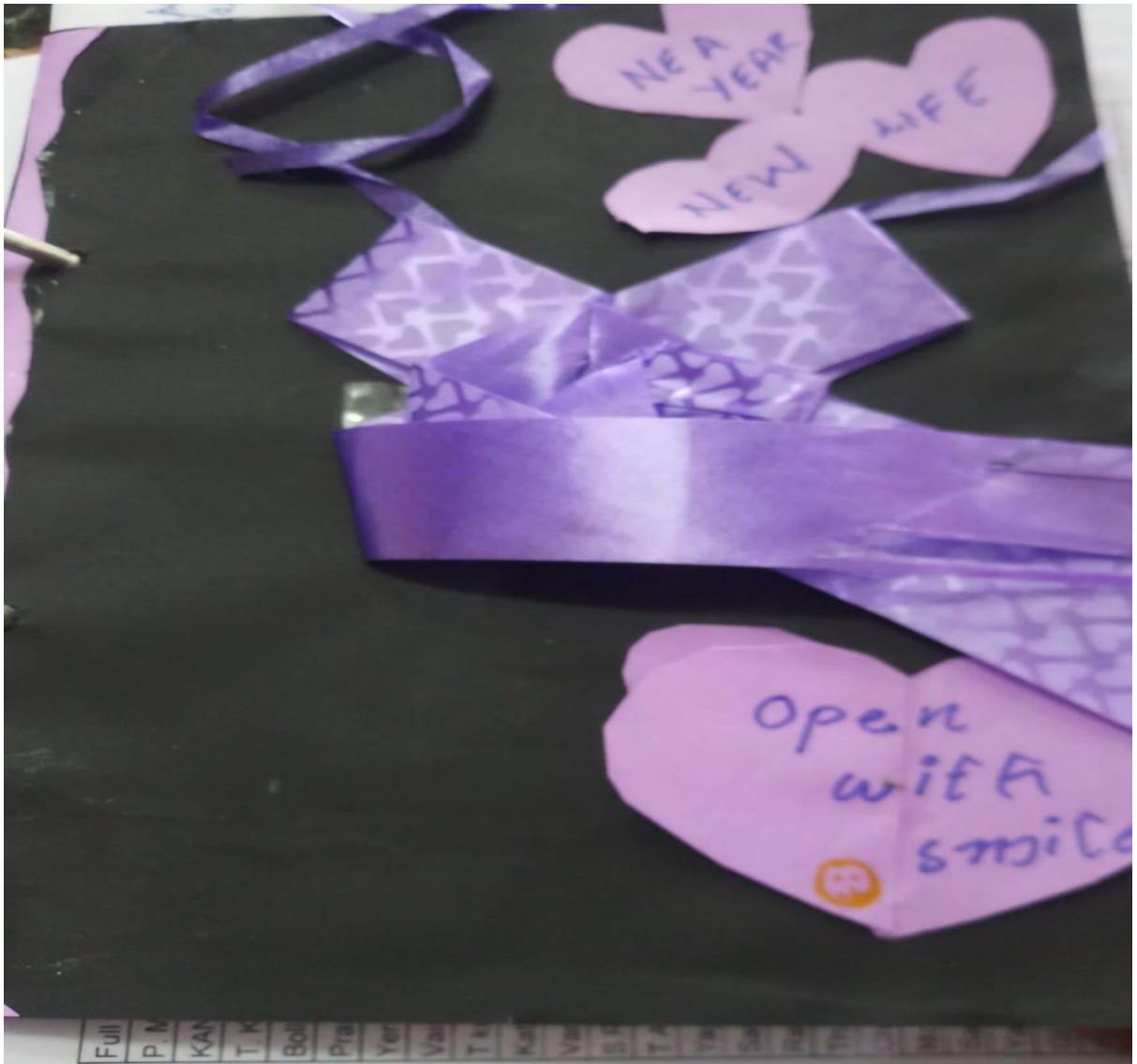
ACTIVITY III: Report on Yuletide and New Year Celebrations

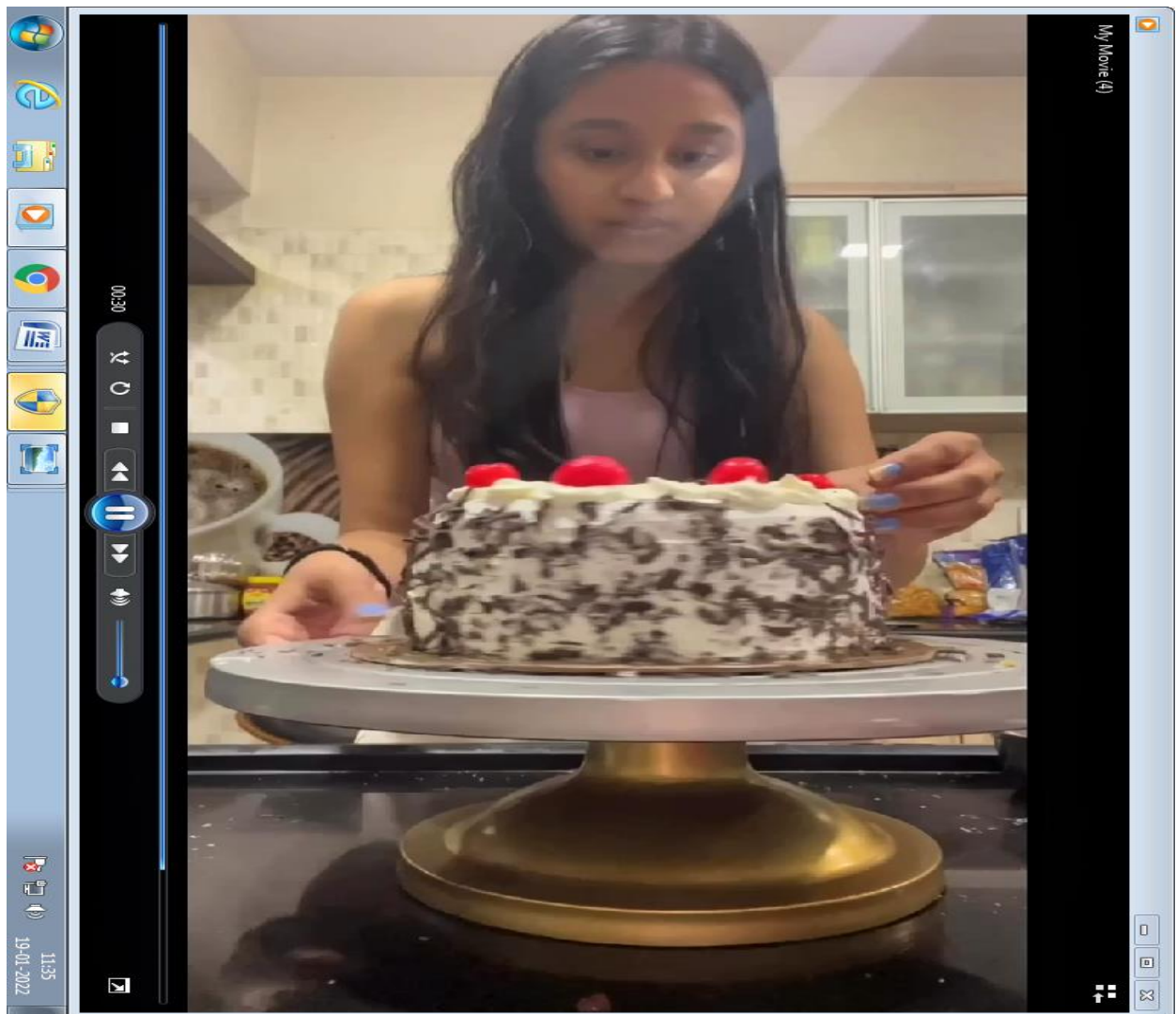

Forty-five students participated in the events.

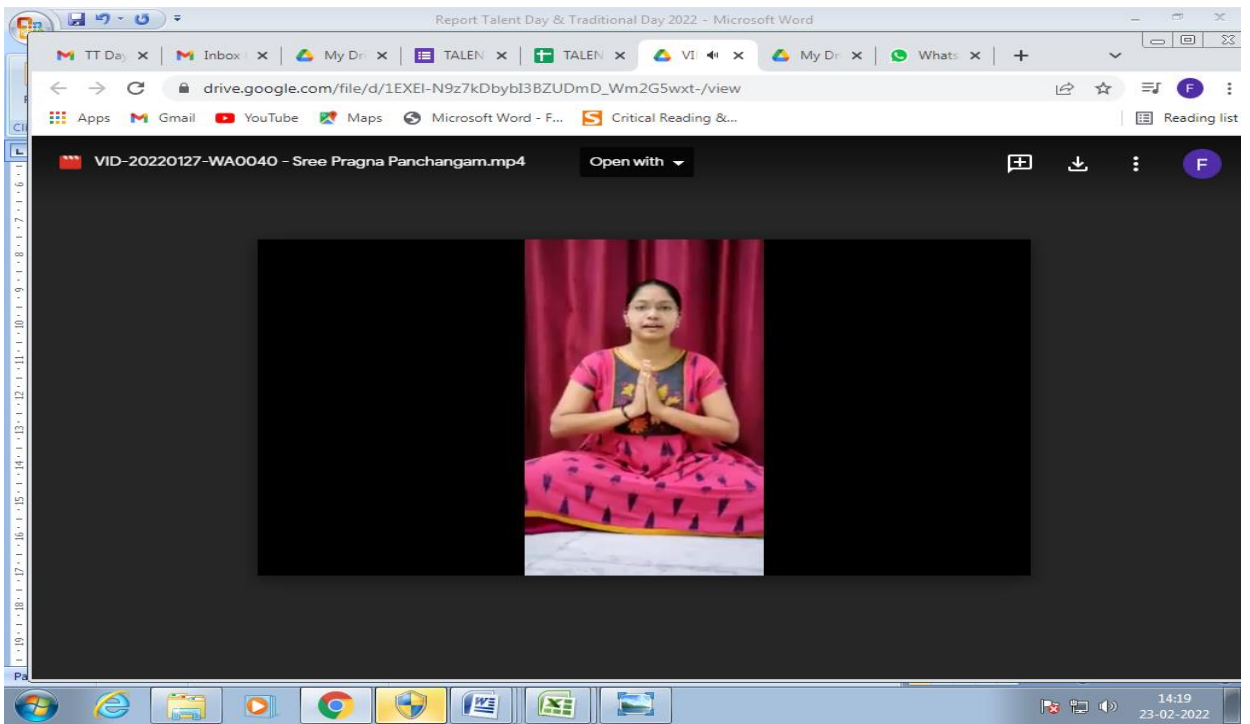
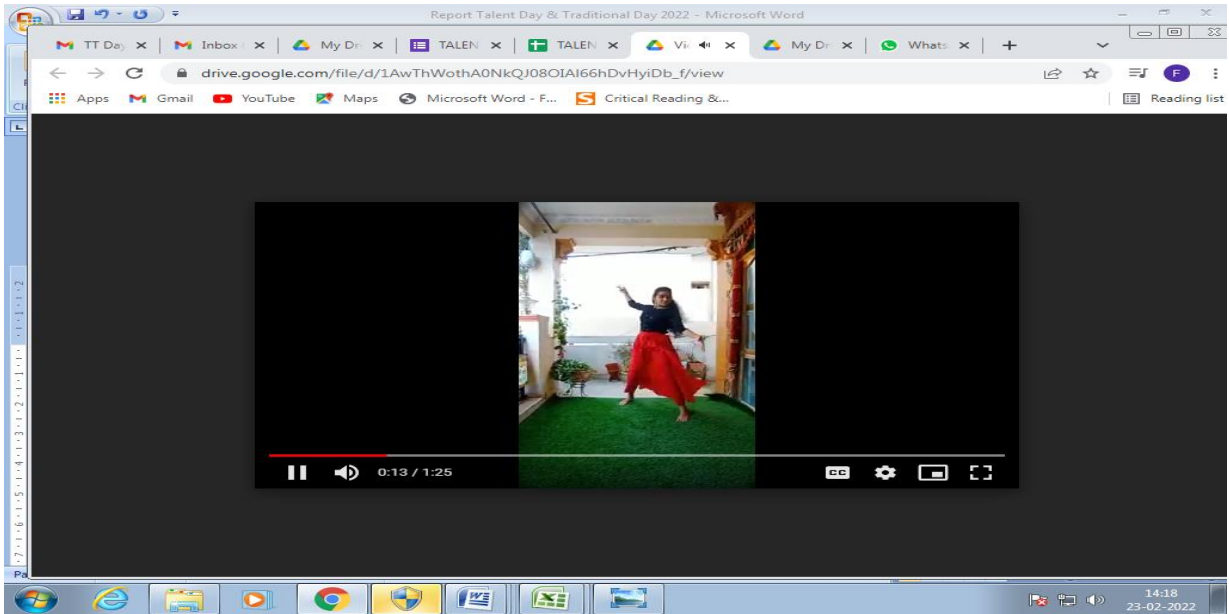

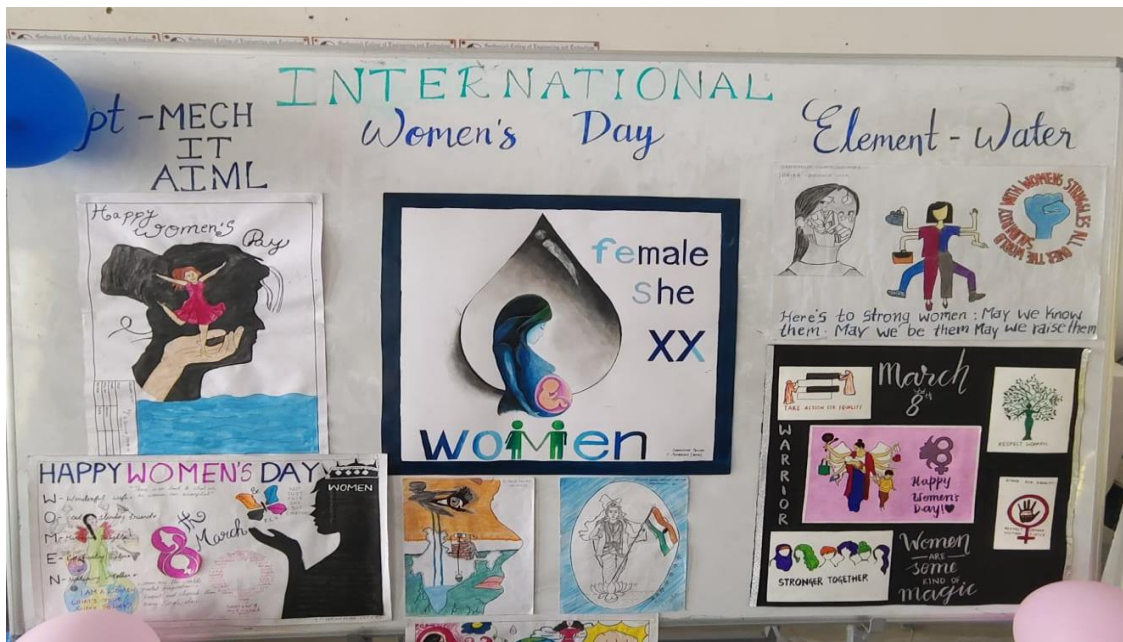
1. Date: 05.03.2022 (Saturday)
