



And one among them being "BECOMING" by Michelle Qbama has really been exhilarating. As if at some point you become something and that's the end". This quote an extract from the autobiography has touched me deeply as a child.

"BECOMINIO" is a 448 expansion of autobiography on what the politics deeply did to her (Michelle Qbgmg) and how it has affected her professionally and personally and how it has helped her grow as a human and understand the problems that has been conquering the nation, even while explaining the worst scenarios she tends to give a positively-healthy cover up at the end. The book is not completely about woman empowerment, but also highlights the sections about her childhood and college years.
