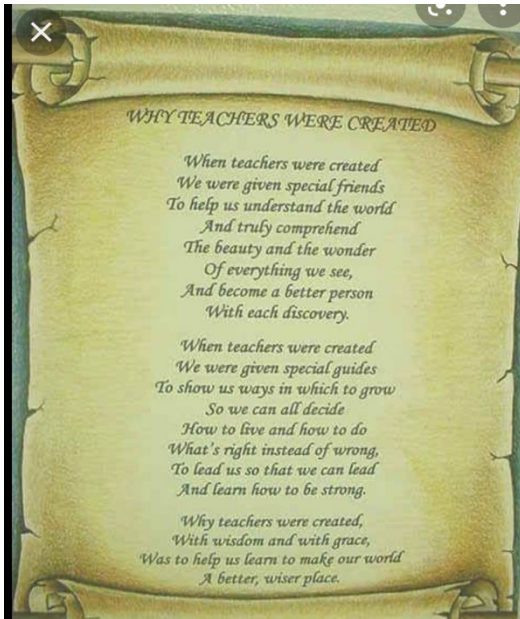
#### REPORT

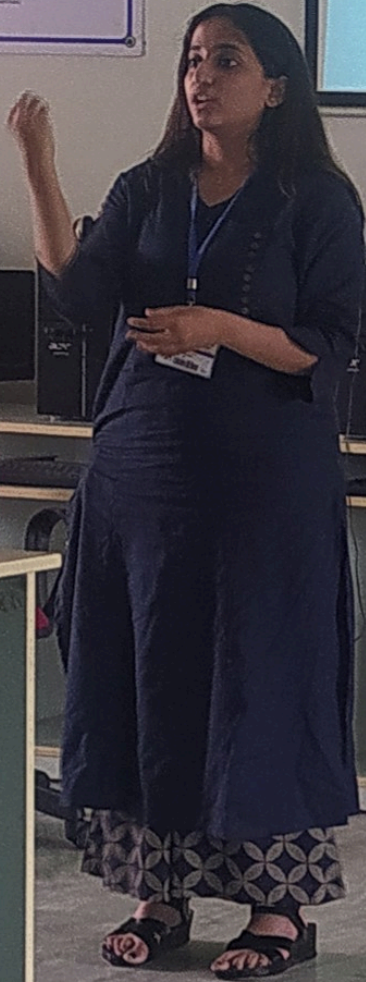

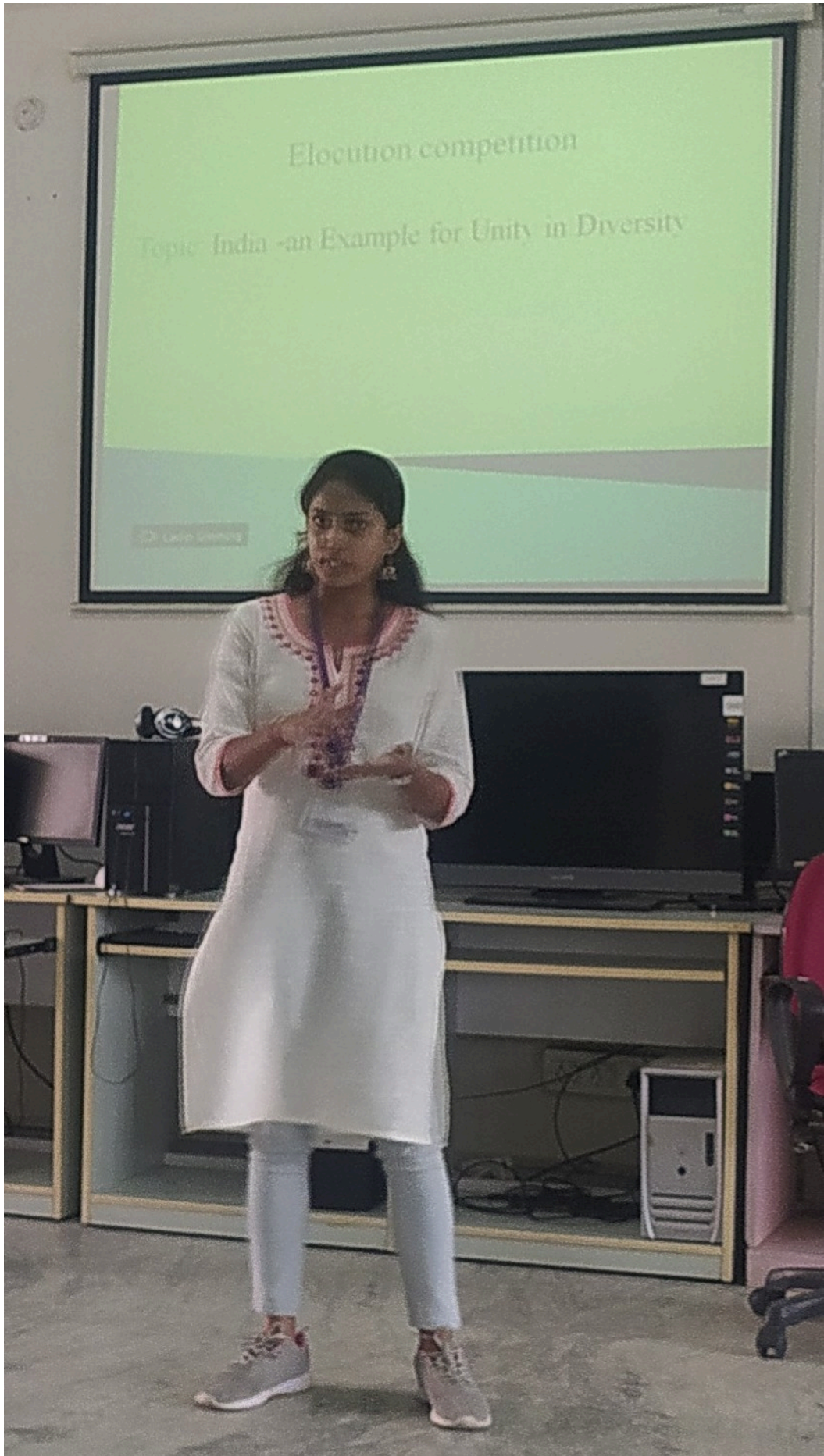

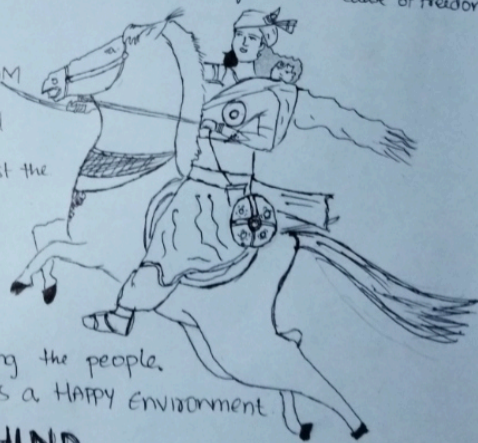

**Resource Person:** Dr. T Senthamarai from Vels Institute of Technology and Advanced Studies, Chennai.

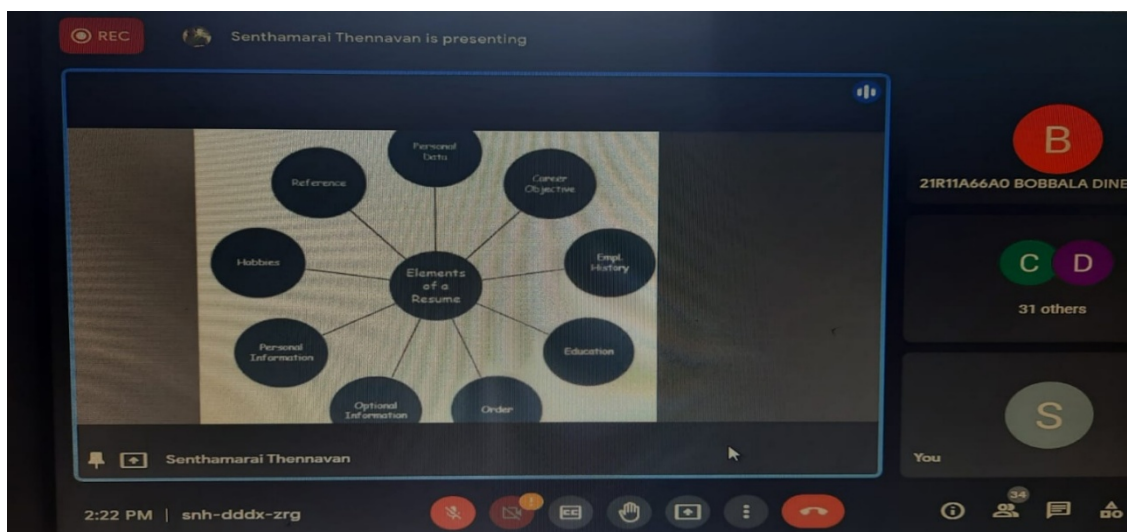
**Guest Lecture In-charge:** Dr T. Sridevi

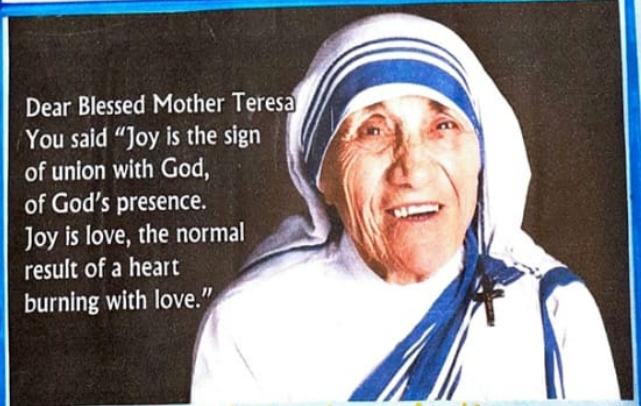

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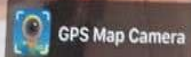

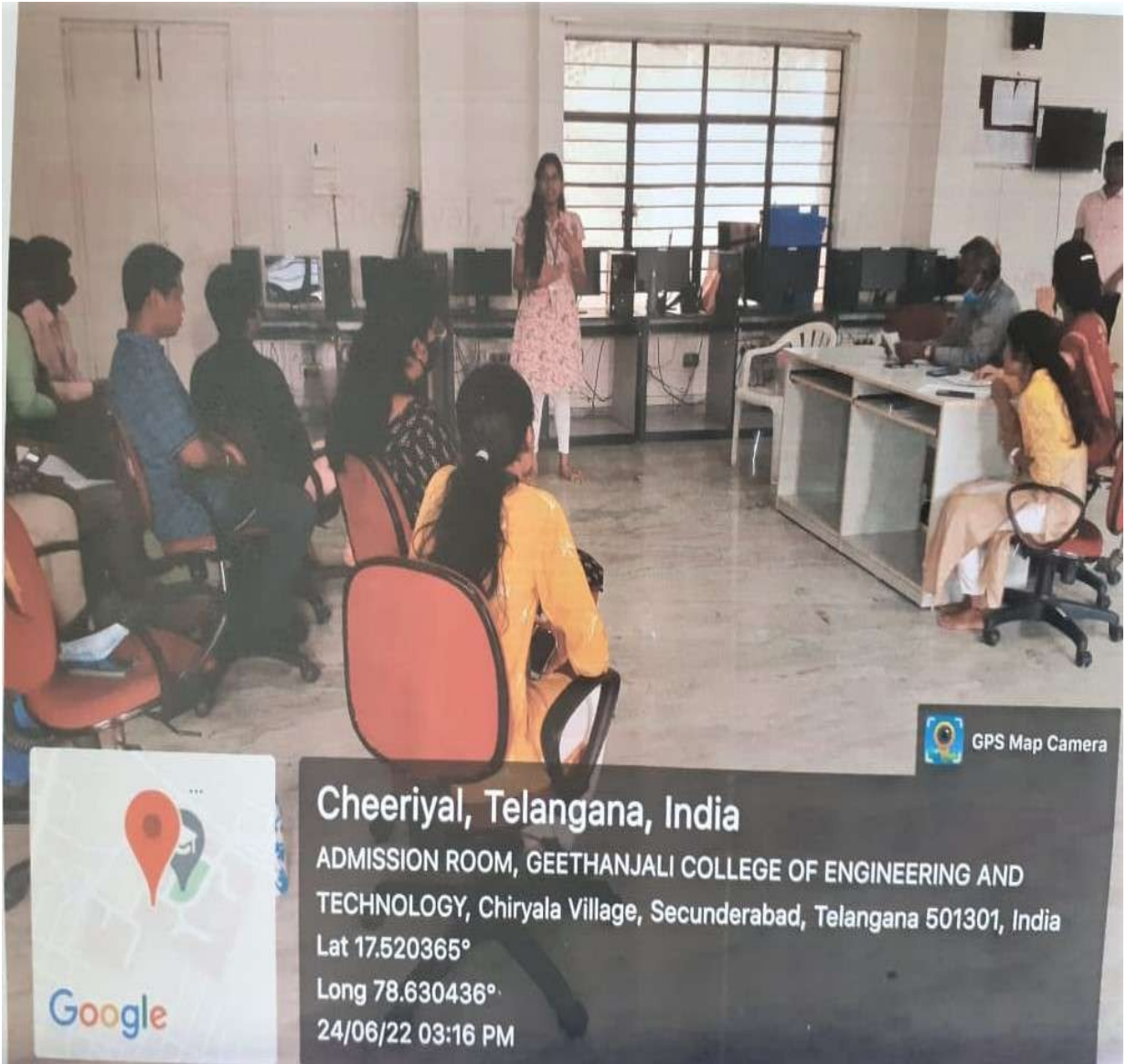
