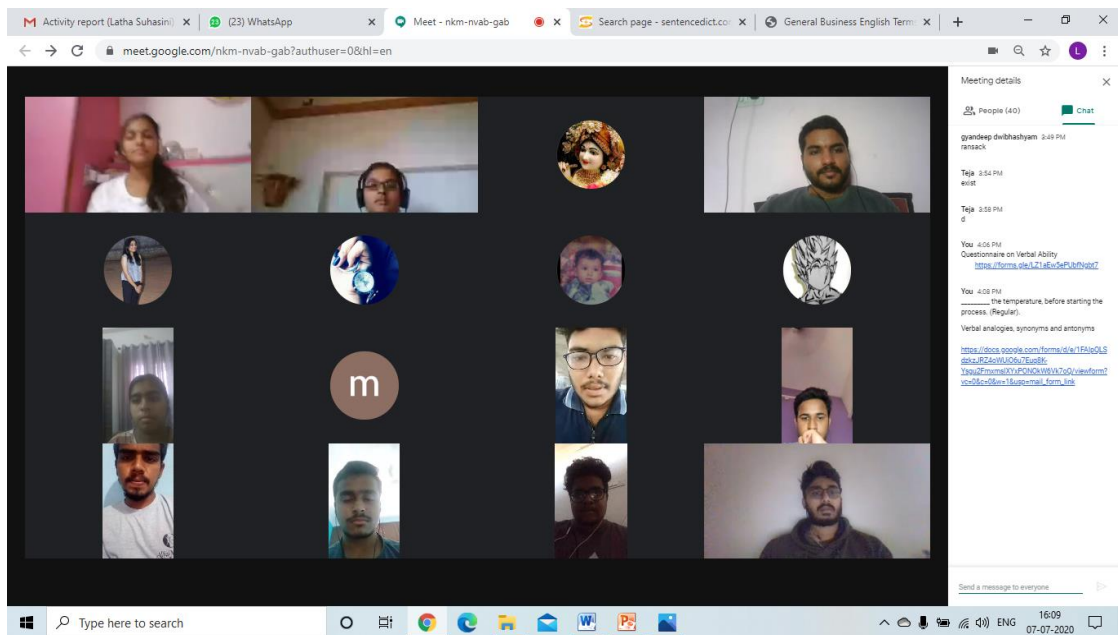

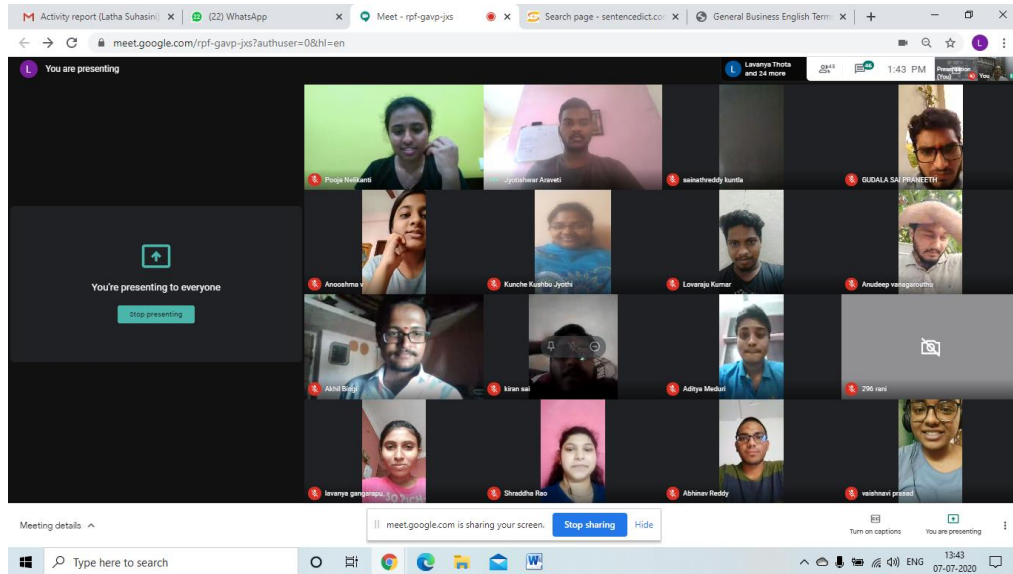
Centre for Soft Skills Development

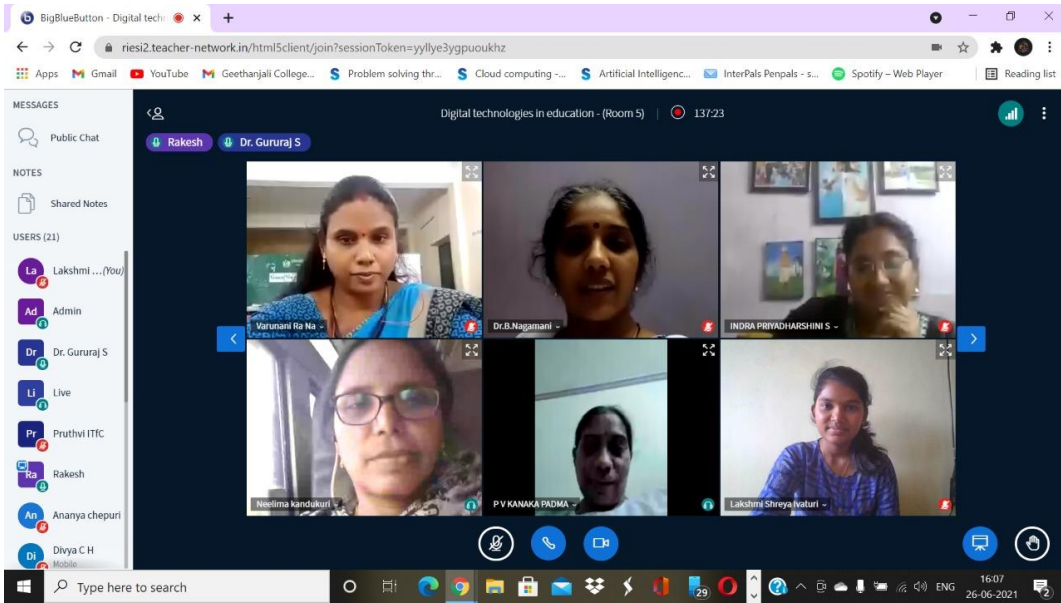

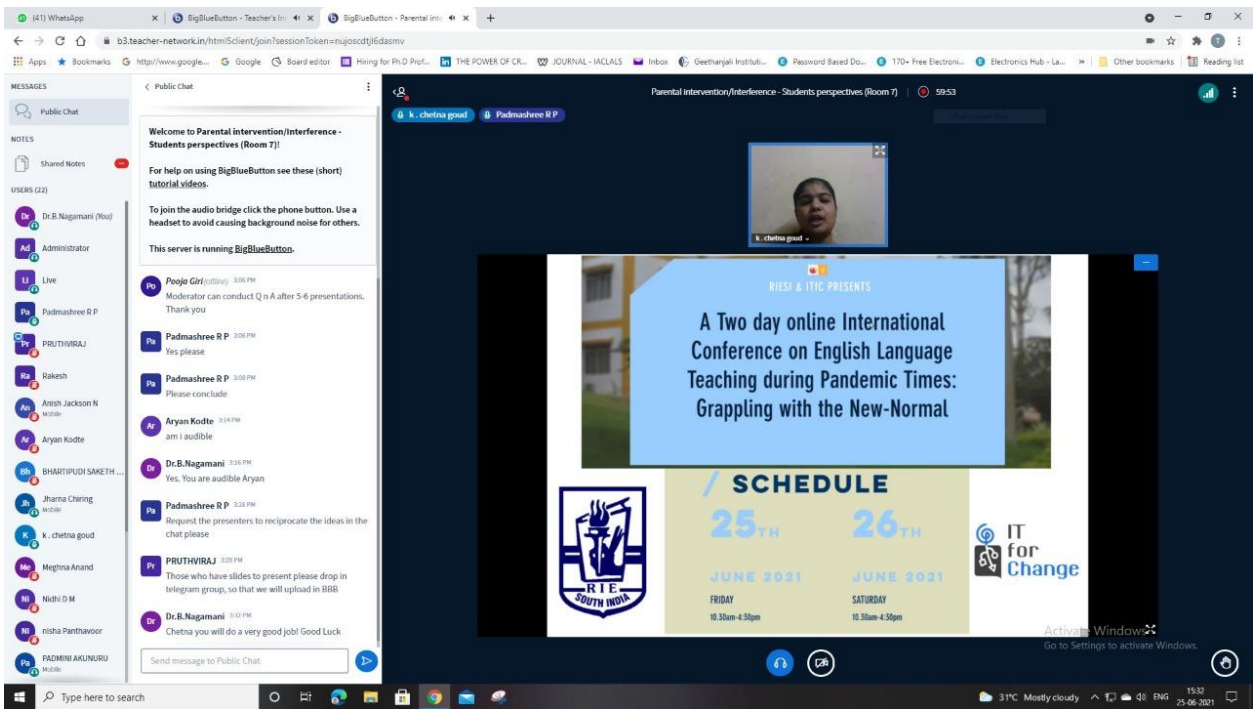
