2. The importance of having improved interaction with industries is discussed. All the

departments are advised to improve their tie up with industries by having MoUs with

various industries that eventually help the students in improving their knowledge in core

areas. Departments are advised to explore the possibilities of providing consultancy

services to the industries, providing internships, arranging guest lectures with industry

experts, and arranging industrial visits.

3. It is observed that the special placement training programs conducted for the student

batch of 2016-20 has increased the placements substantially from 547 to 748 compared to

the student batch of 2015-19. In view of this it is decided to continue these training

programs for the student batch of 2017-21, inducting more number of students into the

training program for improving the placements further.

Minutes of the Meeting

- 1. Academic ambience in the college needs to be improved. A layout describing the location of various departments. Library, Canteen and Placement cell shall be displayed at the main entrance. Famous educational quotes shall be displayed in the corridors of various blocks to improve academic ambience.
- 2. Activities that are planned as per Strategic Plan of the college are to be reviewed at the department level at regular intervals to take appropriate measures for the implementation of the same. Departments shall strive hard to bring-in continuous improvement in the following areas to realize Vision and Missions of the institute.
 - a. Quality Undergraduate Teaching-Learning
 - b. Students' Training & Placements and Higher Education
 - c. Research Development/ Consultancy/ Innovations and Creativity
- 3. Members of the committee discussed regarding the circular issued by JNTUH (Annexure II. Lr. No. Al/B.Tech. Honors/B.Tech. Minor degree /2022 Date: 24.01.2022), facilitating affiliated and autonomous colleges to offer B.Tech minor programs in emerging areas with effect from the academic year 2022-23. Our college is intending to offer B.Tech programs with minoring in emerging areas, namely, Artificial Intelligence & Machine Learning (AIML), Cyber Security (CS), Data Science (DS) and Internet of Things (IoT) from the academic year 2022-23. In this context, it is advised that the non-CSE departments shall encourage their students to opt for minor programs in the area of their interest. This step would enhance the employability of undergraduate students, as there would be better opportunities in interdisciplinary areas of engineering and technology.
- 4. Development of additional space in the form of classrooms, seminar rooms etc. and modernizing the classrooms and labs with ICT facilities to accommodate the increase in intake of students shall be given a serious thought for better Teaching-Learning-Process.
- 5. It is observed that the special placement training programs conducted for the students have brought substantial improvement in the placements. In view of this, it is decided to continue these training programs for the student batch of 2019-23, inducting more number of students into the training program for improving the placements further. Also

the departments are advised to offer Value Added Courses that improve the employability skills of students.

Maintenance of data at a central point and its immediate retrieval upon necessity, of all the academic activities carried out by the departments, is one of the hardships being faced by the college in the present situation. This data is required to apply for NAAC, NBA and Autonomous accreditations, NIRF and other ranking systems and for preparation of college newsletter, brochure etc. In this regard it is proposed to provide a separate room for all the coordinators of IQAC representing various departments and the individual coordinators may be provided with desktop computers to main the data of the individual departments. while summary of these activities is prepared and maintained by the IQAC in-charge. This information which can be made password protected, may be kept in a server, accessible to all higher officials of our college through intranet like the way students are accessing the Digital Library at present.
