Minutes of the Twelfth Academic Council Meeting

Venue: Conference Hall of the College

Date: 12-07-2019.

At the outset, Dr.Udaya Kumar Susarla, Principal extended a warm welcome to all the members of the Academic Council. Subsequently, the Minutes of the previous Academic Council (AC) meeting were read through and ratified by the Academic Council.

Principal later gave a presentation in which he:

- Apprised the members on the major achievements of the college since the last AC.
- Informed the members about the sanction of new course B.Tech Information Technology (IT) from academic year 2019-2020 onwards.
- Presented
 - i. an analysis of results of the examinations,
 - ii. a list of students involved in malpractice,
 - iii. a list of students detained due to shortage of attendance,
 - iv. a list of students detained due to shortage in number of credits required for promotion to higher class,in various undergraduates programs of engineering pertaining to different years and semesters, as well as P.G. Courses.(MBA and M.Tech) of both AR16 and AR 18 Regulations.
- Informed the members about the consultancy projects taken up by Civil Engineering Department.
- Briefed the members about various training programs conducted for students of III and IV years by reputed organizations.
- Notified the members about student participation in IoT based Training program.
- Apprised the members about the indigenous aircrafts, electric scooter, bicycle and seed sowing machine designed by the students. Also informed the members that The Indian Council of Agricultural Research (**ICAR**) has shown interest to interact with the students and fund the seed sowing machine project.

Suggestions

When Principal brought to the notice of the Academic Council that JNTUH changed the credit requirement for promotion to Third year for Lateral Entry students, Dr. Ch. Venkat Ramana Reddy, Professor of Chemistry, Director,UIIC, JNTUH, has suggested that GCET also follow

the same promotion rule followed in JNTUH, i.e 50% of the total credits in case of lateral entry students for promoting them from II year to III year under AR16 and AR 18 regulations. The suggestion was agreed to by all other members.

- Dr.P.G.Sastry opined that Project Based Learning is superior to conventional learning and hence it has to be an integral part of teaching learning process. Principal informed that project based learning has been taken up in one or two engineering courses in II year and III year for every section in both semesters. He also briefed the members about project based learning taken up in the last summer by the department of ECE. Nearly 200 students of ECE, CSE and EEE who completed their I B.Tech actively participated in "Digital Design" training program.
- Dr.P.G.Sastry emphasized to take up an inter-disciplinary approach in all aspects of teaching learning process. He also suggested to take OBE seriously and work towards sustainable education and development.
- Heads of the Department presented various activities taken up, achievements of faculty and students. They concluded their presentation by briefing the members about the various project proposals sent for approval to various funding agencies.

Approvals

The Academic Council accorded the following approvals:

- Approved names of external members for BoS of B. Tech program in IT offered by IT department.
- To apply AR 18 regulations of B. Tech CSE, ECE, EEE, CIVIL and MECH to B. Tech IT and follow the Syllabus of I year of CSE/EEE/ECE for the newly introduced branch "Information Technology" (B.Tech (IT)) as well.
- The changes made in program structure of EEE, change of codes in ECE and open elective offered in M.Tech II year/II sem by MBA department.
- Academic Calendars with slight modification of Dusserah Vacation. It is approved to give Dusserah break from 5th October to 12th October to students and three days for faculty.
- The syllabus of B. Tech III year and IV year of all UG programs under AR18 regulations
Principal thanked the members for their valuable suggestions and inputs and invited them for dinner.
