Minutes of the 35th Academic Council Meeting held on 18th December, 2023, at 03.30 PM

Online mode

At the outset, Dr. Udaya Kumar Susarla, Principal and Chairman of the Academic Council, extended a warm and hearty welcome to all the members of the Academic Council.

The Agenda items already circulated to all the members were, then, taken up, seriatim, for discussions.

Item No 1: Confirmation of the minutes of the 34th Academic Council Meeting held on 07.12.2023 at 4.00 P.M.

Approval: The Minutes of the Previous (Thirty Fourth) Academic Council Meeting as attached in annexure-I were presented by the Principal and duly approved by the members.

Item No 2: To consider and approve relaxation in promotion rules for the AR 22, AR 20 regulations of B.Tech students of GCET in pursuance of the JNTUH circular Procs. No. A1/16/2023 dated 15th December, 2023.

Proceedings and Discussion: Initiating the discussion, Controller of Examinations has presented the relaxation in credit based detention system incorporated by JNTUH vide Procs. No. A1/16/2023 dated 15th December, 2023.

The R18 regulations of JNTUH administered for four years. Next revision in syllabus and course structure of JNTUH took place in 2022. However, in GCET we have revised the syllabus in the

year 2020, carving out AR20 regulations also. In AR20 regulations, the academic regulations governing programs of study remained the same as AR18 regulations, which in turn are in line with JNTUH R18 regulations. Thus the AR18 and AR20 regulations of GCET are notionally same as R18 regulations of JNTUH. Hence, the relaxation in credit based detention allowed in JNTUH R18 regulations are to be extended to AR20 regulations of GCET. However, students from AR18 regulations of GCET have completed their course work in AY 2022-23.

In AR22 regulations of GCET, which, verbatim same as R22 regulations of JNTUH. Same relaxation in credit based detention rules is to be extended to AR22 of GCET.

Controller of Examinations sought the consent of the members to amend the credit based detention rules of AR20 and AR22 regulations of GCET.

Approval: Members approved the relaxation in promotion rules for the AR 22, AR 20 regulations of B.Tech students of GCET in pursuance of the JNTUH circular Procs. No. A1/16/2023 dated 15th December, 2023.

Item No. 3: To consider and approve revision in grace marks to the students who are graduating under AR18 regulations and awarding grace marks to the students under AR20 regulations (2020, 2021 admitted batches) vide JNTUH directive- Procds. No. JNTUH/EB/Grace Marks/2/2023 dated 14.12.2023

Proceedings and Discussion: Controller of Examinations apprised the members of the academic council on the revision in grace marks of Thirty (30) for regular B.Tech and Twenty three (23) for Lateral Entry students of B.Tech respectively, vide JNTUH directive, Procds. No. JNTUH/EB/Grace Marks/2/2023 dated 14.12.2023 to the students of R18 regulations of JNTUH. As presented earlier, the R18 regulations of JNTUH are notionally equivalent to both AR18 and AR20 regulations of GCET. The academic regulations and the total credits are same.

Hence, Controller of Examinations sought the consent of the members to permit the college to adopt revision in grace marks to both AR18 and AR20 regulations of GCET.

Approval: Members approved the revision in grace marks to the students who are graduating under AR18 regulations and awarding grace marks to the students under AR20 regulations (2020,
