Minutes of the Seventh Academic Council Meeting Held on June 23, 2018 in the Board room of the College

Present: List of members who attended the meeting is enclosed (Annexure-A)

Agenda: The agenda for the meeting is enclosed (Annexure-B)

At the outset, Dr. Udaya Kumar Susarla, Principal extended a warm welcome to all the members of the Academic Council. He also appraised the members about the NBA Team's visit on 22.6.2018 regarding GCET's NBA Compliance Report of B.Tech CSE, EEE and ECE Programs. The proceedings of the meeting and the decisions taken are as follows:

Item 1: Approval of the minutes of the meeting held on February 09, 2018 and "Action Taken Report" on the suggestions given by members in the same meeting

The minutes of the Academic Council Meeting held on 09-02-2018 and the Action Taken Report presented by Principal and concerned Heads of the departments, on the suggestions given by members in the meeting were ratified by Academic Council. As part of the ATR of previous meeting regarding the suggestions given by the members, Principal mentioned that it was decided to wait till JNTUH completes the preparation of curriculum based on AICTE model curriculum and initiated the discussion in the light of the model of the curriculum designed by JNTUH that was placed on its website.

- Discussion on the Program structure of AICTE Model Curriculum with slight Modifications, if any, from the academic year 2018-19
 - i. Both JNTUH Nominees: Dr. N.Yadaiah, Registrar JNTUH and Dr. Manzoor Hussain have appraised members that JNTUH has finalized the JNTUH Affiliated colleges' program structure under AICTE Model Curriculum for all disciplines in B.Tech and advised the college to contact DAP, JNTUH for further details.
 - ii. Dr. N. Yadaiah, Registrar JNTUH advised the Principal GCET to constitute a committee to propose the Model curriculum (if possible with one or two External Members) and subsequently attempt at convening a Joint BoS of all the Disciplines before finalizing the Model Curriculum indicating clearly to the Joint BoS about the expectations of each department on the proposed model curriculum;

- iii. Further, he suggested to first include the common courses of all the departments and then explore the flexibility of fixing the discipline specific courses in the remaining slots.
- Principal GCET appraised the academic council that GCET did a similar exercise (of course, without any external members) and proposed officially to the DAP, JNTUH Model Curriculum for all the disciplines: EEE, ECE, CSE, CE, and ME, within the deadline the DAP has provided and is awaiting to hear from the JNTUH about the same. Also the proposed curriculum of all the five disciplines (as above) are made open for scrutiny and suggestions for improvement by the JNTUH Nominees.
- Dr. Manzoor Hussain garu went through the Model Curriculum proposed by the Mechanical Engineering Department of the GCET. While observing the structure proposed for various semesters he appreciated that it is Five theory courses and three lab courses and felt it may become 4 theory and 4 lab courses per semester in the near future.
- Dr. N. Yadaiah garu went through the Model Curriculum proposed by the Electrical and Electronics Engineering Department of the GCET

Dr. N. Yadaiah garu suggested

- a. to avoid a fractional number total credits per semester whenever the structure is proposed (for example 20.5 or 17.5 etc; instead suggested to make it 21 or 20 Or 17 or 18). He suggested examining whether "really 3 full clock periods" are needed for practical sessions of a laboratory course; to avoid accrual of fractional total credits at the end of a semester.
- b. to include slots for sports, library and other activities also across disciplines.
- c. to replace "Physics-I" with Physics, in the pre-requisite column during I year II semester.
- d. to bring into II-I and II-II semester. courses on Power Systems and then introduce "Power System Protection" rather than the current proposal wherein Power System Protection comes before Power System-I and Power systems -II during III-II and IV-I semesters respectively. Also he suggested to include courses such as Digital Signal Processing as Mandatory courses for B. Tech. EEE Students.

- e. to make faculty undergo/expose-to MOOCs & NPTEL Courses and prescribe the same for the students during their III or IV year of study as Open Electives in the curriculum

- Dr Yadaiah Garu suggested that instead of conducting conference on many topics, attempt should be made to conduct on a specialized topic or on a few specialized topics in one area under the auspices of a professional body such as IEEE.
- With regard to Industrial Visits, Dr. N. Yadaiah garu suggested to attempt at conducting Industrial visit to T-Hub for B.Tech. CSE students
