Changes made in certain clauses of AR22 Regulations - B. Tech

7.1 A student shall be deemed to have satisfied the academic requirements and earned the credits allotted to each subject/ course, if student secures not less than 35% (14 marks out of 40 marks) in the Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE), not less than 35% (21 marks out of 60 marks) in the semester end examinations (SEE), and a minimum of 40% (40 marks out of 100 marks) in the sum total of the CIE (Continuous Internal Evaluation) and SEE (Semester End Examination) taken together; in terms of letter grades, this implies securing 'C' grade or above in that subject/ course.

8.4 A student can re-register for courses/subjects in a semester:

- If the internal marks secured by a student in the Continuous Internal Evaluation marks for 40 (Sum of average of two mid-term examinations consisting of objective and descriptive parts, Average of two Assignments and Subject Vivavoce/ PPT/ Poster presentation/ Case Study on a topic in the concerned course/subject) are less than 35% and failed in those courses/subjects.

They may seek re registration for all those courses/subjects registered in that semester in which the student is failed. The student has to re-appear for CIE and SEE as and when offered.

A student must re-register for the failed course(s)/subject(s) for 40 marks within four weeks of commencement of the class work in next academic year. His Continuous Internal Evaluation marks for 40 obtained in the previous attempt stand cancelled. The student has to obtain fresh set of marks for 40 allotted for CIE (Sum of average of two mid-term examinations consisting of objective & descriptive parts, Average of two Assignments & Subject Viva-voce/PPT/ Poster presentation/ Case Study on a topic in the concerned course/subject). **Head of the Dept. will take care of this.**

14. Transitory Regulations

A. For students detained due to shortage of attendance:

1. A student who has been detained in any semester of I, II, III and IV years of AR18/AR20 regulations for want of attendance, shall be permitted to join the corresponding semester of AR22 Regulations and is required to complete the study of B.Tech. within the stipulated period of eight academic years from the date of first admission in I Year. The AR22 Academic Regulations under which a student has been readmitted shall be applicable to that student from that semester. See rule 14.C for further Transitory Regulations.
